

MSEE:

Develop Thesis\Dissertation Abstract and define deliverables approximately one year prior to defense.

- Create Abstract assuming research will be successful
- Be sure to define contributions and deliverables
- Include NABCs in your abstract
- After discussions be sure to have approval (“Buy-In”) from entire Committee... keep an open mind regarding suggestions/direction.

Make sure you complete a degree check with the ELEG Department

Ensure your thesis\dissertation meets all formatting, content, and review requirements with the Graduate School

- Submit outline and abstract to Graduate School early on to obtain approval.

MSEE students should have a thesis with around 100 pages of content

- Write with the concept of a future student being able to learn and re-accomplish your work over the course of a month or two.
- Archive work and required instructions in Appendices.

Day of Defense/Presentation

- Arrive at least 15 minutes early in case of technical issues
- Dress in “business informal” attire (Suit up)
- Ask Staff to deliver documents to professors for signatures
- Presentations for MSEE Students are expected to be approximately 30 minutes
- Presentations for Ph.D. Students are expected to be approximately 45 minutes
